
Machine Shorthand





Machine shorthand writers press multiple keys down at the same time to form syllables, words, or even entire phrases in a single downward stroke. "Missing" letters are formed by combining other letters together. For instance, there is no "n" on the initial side of the keyboard. TPH is pressed together to represent the letter N at the beginning of a syllable, word, or phrase.
