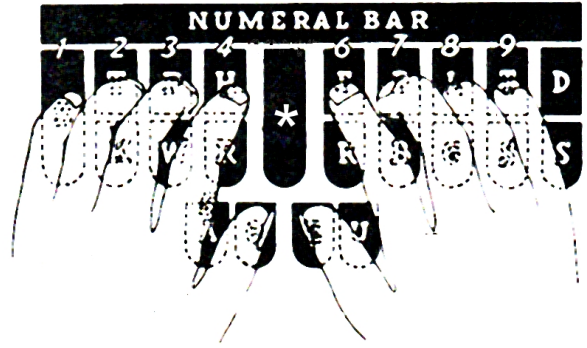


# Try Machine Shorthand!

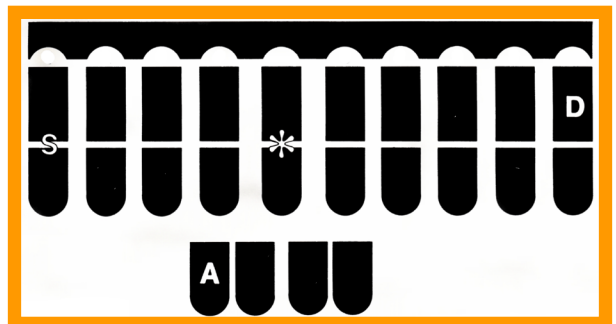
Phonetic writing, a word or syllable with every stroke.

Place your hands on the keys like this.

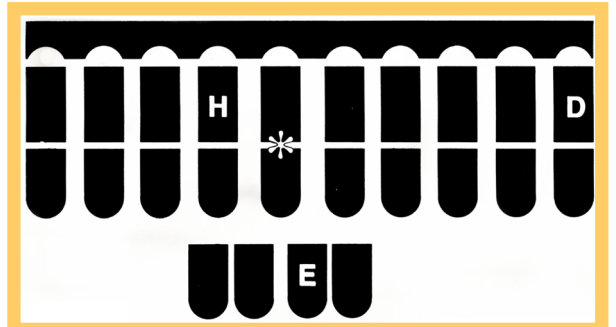
Press all of the keys under your fingers down at the same time, then release. This is called a “stroke.”



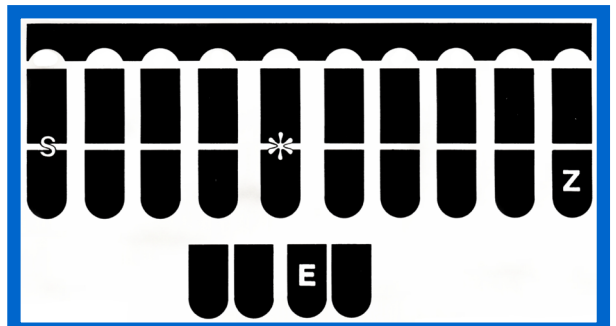
Write the word “sad.” Push all three keys down at the same time!  
Use your left pinky finger on the S, left thumb on the A, and right pinky finger on the D.



Write the word “head.” Remember, we’re writing phonetically!



Write the word “says.”



Write the word “seize.”  
E plus the two keys under the opposite thumb equals the long E sound.
